CATTLE CLASSES

REGRETFULLY NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED.

Conditions of Entry

Please ensure that you are aware of the current DEFRA regulations, in particular with regard to Blue Tongue, concerning the showing of cattle.

1. Cattle entries will only be accepted from herds, which are fully accredited within the Brucellosis Scheme.
2. Cows or heifers calving at the Show or which have signs of abnormal discharge must be placed in the isolation pen provided and the Cattle Secretary notified immediately, who will in turn notify the Divisional Veterinary Officer.
3. Exhibitors in Classes 2 & 3 must be prepared to have their Exhibits milked out in the ring if so instructed by the Judge, and in any case prior to the judging of the Supreme Champion Exhibit.
4. A milking machine will be provided for the benefit of the Exhibitors.
5. **Please ensure that you are aware of the B.C.M.S. rules connected with the movement of Cattle, and the current DEFRA rules and regulations regarding Blue Tongue.**
6. No animals to be removed from the showground before the Parade.
7. All entries must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor for at least 3 months prior to the Show.
8. To the best of our knowledge, all information and rules correct at time of schedule going to print.
9. Prize money paid after Parade.
10. ALL LIVESTOCK MUST BE COVERED BY VALID PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE.

2. All sheep must comply with dipping regulations in force at the time of the Show.
3. Licences must accompany all sheep.
4. No M.V. sheep to be offloaded without Green Certificate of Accreditation forms being handed to steward.
5. Small Flock Owners to enter any Class, except Class 19.
6. Indicate on entry form if you are a Small Flock Owner.
SMALL FLOCK MEANS UP TO TWELVE SHEEP IN TOTAL.
7. The highest-placed Small Flock Owner in each Class to go forward for the Small Flock Owners' Championship.
8. Special Rosettes to be given for the highest-placed Small Flock Owner in each Class.
9. All handlers/exhibitors to remain with sheep until judging is over.
10. No animals to be removed from Showground before 3.30pm
11. To the best of our knowledge, all information and rules correct at time of schedule going to print.
12. All entries must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor for at least 3 months prior to the Show.
13. **All livestock must be covered by valid public liability insurance.**
